The main tasks of Operation 'Atalanta' are to prevent piracy and protect vulnerable maritime traffic, such as the World Food Program ships.

Frigate 'Numancia' docked in the port of Souda (Greece) after four days of sailing from the Rota Naval Base. The frigate joins EUNAVFOR Somalia in the framework of Operation 'Atalanta' which takes place in the waters of the Indian Ocean.

This Helicopter Unit is mainly made up of personnel from the Army Airmobile Forces (FAMET in Spanish) and its main mission is intratheater airlift for the EUTM Mali mission, both personnel and equipment.
