SPECIAL OPERATIONS COMPONENT COMMAND HQ PARTICIPATED IN NATO EXERCISE 'STEADFAST DAGGER 24'

Steadfast Dagger 24 (STDA24) is a command post exercise, planned and coordinated by the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SACEUR).

This exercise brings together military personnel from all Alliance member countries in Norway to test the operational capability of the Allied Response Force 25 (ARF25)

THE FRIGATE 'CRISTOBAL COLON' F-105 TRACKS RUSSIAN NAVAL UNITS IN THE EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN SEA

The frigate 'Cristobal Colon' (F-105) has been monitoring the activities of several naval units of the Russian Federation in the Eastern Mediterranean.

To be precise, the 'Cristóbal Colón' has taken charge of a Russian naval group composed of two frigates of the 'Almiral Gorshkov' class, and one of the 'Almiral Grigorovich' class, as well as the Kilo II class submarine that was in the area to carry out naval exercises with the other Russian maritime units.

At the end of December, 'SOTG XXI' participated in activities with Iraqi Special Forces in Salahadin, Diyala and Anbar governorates. Two of these operations were conducted in cooperation with American and French Special Operation Units, demonstrating the high level of interoperability between the countries belonging to the international coalition against Daesh deployed in Iraq since 2015.

These training missions involve guiding aircraft, so that they can provide support without endangering their own troops.

The six Eurofighter C16 aircraft of the Tactical Air Detachment 'Paznic', deployed at Mihail Kogalniceanu Air Base, Romania, as part of NATO's Integrated Air and Missile Defense, Eastern Flank (NATO IAMD-Persistent Effort), have conducted a series of Close Air Support (CAS) training missions with US and French military personnel.

Fifty members of the Central African Armed Forces (FACA) have begun a one-year training course at the new Non-Commissioned Officers School.

AS PART OF OPERATION ATALANTA, THE FRIGATE F-81 SANTA MARÍA CONDUCTS ANTI-PIRACY PATROLS IN THE INDIAN OCEAN

During its deployment as part of Operation Atalanta, the frigate 'Santa María' has conducted anti-piracy patrols in the Indian Ocean, near the Seychelles, Madagascar and the Mozambique Channel.

The 'Santa María' has monitored the hijacking of a Chinese fishing vessel, which fell into the hands of Somali armed pirates at the beginning of December and was released on 13 January.
