



## Major General José Antonio Herrera Llamas, Head of the ESP Joint Staff Plans Division

Major General José Antonio Herrera Llamas was born in Málaga on August the 22<sup>nd</sup> of 1963. He joined the Air Force in 1980, and was commissioned first lieutenant on July the 16<sup>th</sup> of 1985, upon graduation from the ESP Air Force Academy.

He was further promoted to Captain in 1988, to Major in 1997, to Lieutenant Colonel in 2005 and to Colonel in 2013. In February 2018 is promoted to Brigadier General and in June 2020 to Major General.

Throughout his career he served as a teacher and flight instructor at the Military Air Transport School (Matacán Air Base, Salamanca), pilot of the 31<sup>st</sup> Wing (Zaragoza Air Base), pilot and squadron commander of the 47<sup>th</sup> Group (Torrejón Air Base), and commanded the 45<sup>th</sup> Group (Torrejón Air Base). From an operational perspective, MG Herrera has participated in several missions (Namibia, the Gulf War, Former Yugoslavia, Afghanistan and Atalanta), being awarded the badges of UNPROFOR, IFOR, PERSIAN GULF, ADRIATIC, PROVIDE CONFORT, ISAF and ATALANTA. Between September 2009 and April 2010, he was appointed Air Operations Chief of the NATO KAIA (Kabul International Airport), as part of the ISAF mission. MG Herrera has flown a total of 9.122 flight hours in the following aircraft: Bücker, T-34 “Mentor”, C-101 “Aviojet”, A-36 “Bonanza”, C-212 “Aviocar”, C-130 “Hercules”, Dassault Falcon 20, Boeing B-707, Dassault Falcon 900B and Airbus 310.

He has also served as head of the Joint Centre for Concept Development, Chief of the Logistics Branch in the Operations Command, Chief of the Coordination Section of the Air Staff General Secreteriat, and analyst in the Programmes Section of the Air Staff Plans Division. In these staff positions he had an intense involvement in requirements definition and follow-up of several acquisition and modernisation programmes (such as: C-130 upgrade, Airbus C-295, Airbus A-310, Dassault Falcon 900, A-400M multinational Programme, F/A-18 Electronic Warfare Suite upgrade, etc.); other areas of expertise are force and resources planning, budgeting, programmes development, operational logistics and force development.

In June 2020 MG Herrera was appointed Head of the Force Development Division of the ESP Joint Staff.
