



Major General Pedro Torreño Suárez, Head of the ESP Joint Staff Plans Division

Major General Pedro Torreño Suárez was born in Madrid on February 9th, 1966.

As a Lieutenant and Captain, he served in the XII and VI Field Artillery Groups, in the 82nd Anti-aircraft Artillery Regiment and in the I Intelligence Group. Subsequently, as Commander and Lieutenant Colonel, he held staff positions in the Army Logistic Support Command, in the Defence Staff Operations Command and in the Army Staff. He also served as Commander of Field Artillery Group I/11 and once promoted to Colonel he commanded the Field Artillery Regiment No. 20.

He was promoted to Brigadier General in 2018 and he filled the position of Head of the Logistics Division within the Army Staff.

Promoted to Major General in March 2022, taking over the Force Development Division (EMACON-DIVDEF)

On 26 July 2024, he assumed command of the Plans Division of EMACON. He is currently in this position.

He has been deployed on foreign missions in Bosnia (1997) and Kosovo (2005).
