THE SPANISH FRIGATE WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE 'HIGHTMAST 25' DEPLOYMENT FOR FOUR MONTHS ALONGSIDE VESSELS FROM OTHER ALLIED NATIONS

The ship, part of the Spanish Navy, has joined into the Carrier Strike Group of the UK Royal Navy's HMS 'Prince of Wales' until early August, when the group will head towards the Philippines.

The integration of F-104 in this Carrier Strike Group showcase Spain's technological capability and independence, as well as its ability to project force across diverse geographical areas, reaffirming Spain's commitment to global stability.



BILATERAL TRAINING AND EXERCISE CONFERENCE HELD WITH THE UNITED STATES

The Joint Chiefs of Defence Staff hosted BTEC 2025 to improve interoperability and readiness between the US and Spanish Armed Forces.

This year's BTEC gathered 83 representatives (28 Spanish and 55 from the US), and resulted in the coordination of 122 activities scheduled for 2026.



NATO MINE COUNTERMEASURES GROUP 2 (SNMCMG 2)



MINEHUNTER M-35 'DUERO' PARTICIPATED IN MULTINATIONAL EXERCISE 'ITALIAN MINEX' WITH ALLIED NAVIES

The Duero minehunter (M-35), part of NATO Standing Mine Countermeasures Group 2 (SNMCMG-2), participated in the multinational exercise 'Italian Minex' in waters near the Italian city of Cagliari.

During these manoeuvres, the allied naval units refined their techniques, tactics, and procedures in the detection, classification, and identification of mines.

SUPPORT TO TÜRKIYE



SPANISH CONTINGENT AT XXI AND TURKISH AIR FORCE STRENGTHEN INTEROPERABILITY THROUGH AERIAL TRAINING ACTIVITIES

The Spanish contingent deployed at Incirlik Air Base (Adana) as part of NATO's Support to Türkiye Operation (A/T) conducts regular collaborative training with the Turkish Air Force on regular basis.

These joint activities significantly improve ground-to-air combat training and strengthen integration and interoperability with the armed forces of allied nations.

SPAIN DEPLOYED AMPHIBIOUS CAPABILITY ON THE BLACK SEA COAST

The Marine Corps Detachment, part of the NATO Multinational Battlegroup in Romania, participated in the 'Sea Shield 25' exercise.

During the exercise, Spanish and Romanian units carried out amphibious operations, both on the Black Sea coastline and within the Danube River system.

SPANISH MARINE CORPS SCHOOL CONCLUDES 10TH TACTICAL PLANNING MODULE FOR UKRAINIAN OFFICERS

The Spanish Marine Corps School ‘General Albacete y Fuster’ (EIMGAF) concluded the 10th Tactical Land Operations Planning Module for officers of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, held in Cartagena as part of the European Union Military Assistance Mission in support of Ukraine (EUMAM-UA).

The first edition of this module was delivered at EIMGAF in April 2023. Since then, over 225 Ukrainian officers have been trained at the school.
