The 'Eagle Arrow' exercise took place at the Joint National Training Center (JNTC) in Cincu and involved the activation of the battalion and the deployment of maneuver units to their assigned positions within the JNTC. Simultaneously, combat service support elements ensured logistical sustainment by providing fuel, ammunition, and supplies to the deployed forces.

The exercise simulated a natural disaster scenario with multiple casualties. In this context, multiple incidents and operational scenarios occurred due to the degradation and loss of communications and power supply and other obstacles, providing healthcare for many victims. This critical scenario required the coordinated implementation of emergency plans, as well as measures to sustain operations and protect force.

SPAIN LEADS STANDING NATO MARITIME GROUP ONE (SNMG1)

Rear Admiral Ruiz Escagedo assumed command of the group for the next three months during a ceremony held at the Dutch naval base in Den Helder.

The ceremony took place on board the Royal Netherlands Navy ship HNLMS Johan and was presided over by the Deputy Commander of NATO Allied Maritime Command (MARCOM), French Navy Vice Admiral Ludovic Poitou. The ceremony was also attended by the Deputy Chief of Staff Operations at MARCOM, Royal Netherlands Navy Commodore Van Zanten, and the Chief of Staff of the Spanish Joint Operations Command, Vice Admiral Núñez de Prado.



EU NAVFOR – ATALANTA



THE 57TH CONTINGENT OF THE ORION TACTICAL AIR DETACHMENT ENSURES THE MISSION'S OPERATIONAL CAPABILITIES DURING THE MONSOON SEASON

The 57th Tactical Air Detachment (TAD) Orion, deployed as part of Operation EUNAVFOR Atalanta, is responsible for the maintenance of ground support equipment and for improving living areas in order to ensure the operational effectiveness of the mission during the monsoon period, when the D4 aircraft is based in Spain.

Among other measures, new cooling equipment and awnings are being installed to combat the high temperatures reached during the inter-monsoon period and to condition the different areas.

This mission strengthens Spanish commitment to maritime security, international cooperation, and stability in West Africa.

UNIFIL



A PATROL OF THE SPANISH BATTALION IN UNIFIL'S EASTERN SECTOR REMAINS SAFE AND UNHARMED FOLLOWING AN INCIDENT INVOLVING ISRAELI TANKS

Three Israeli tanks took up positions north of the buffer zone within the area of responsibility of the Spanish Battalion (SPANBATT), assigned to UNIFIL's Eastern Brigade, commanded by General Antonio Bernal Martín. The buffer zone is a security area surrounding positions maintained by the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) in Lebanese territory.

The incident occurred south of the town of El Khiam.
