#### THE MARITIME COMPONENT COMMAND OF THE ALLIED REACTION FORCE CONCLUDED THE NORTHERN QUADRIGA 26 EXERCISE

The NATO Allied Reaction Force (ARF) Maritime Component Command (MCC), led by Spain, has supported German units on conducting the exercise Northern Quadriga 26.

The aim of this training activity has been to reinforce presence in the North Sea and the coastal waters of northern Germany, in order to further develop of Germany's national defence capabilities and the Alliance's collective defence.



#### UKRAINE AWARDED WITH CROSS OF MERIT TO SPANISH CHIEF OF DEFENCE

This recognition, together with the "Distinction of Honour for Assistance to the Army" awarded to 33 spanish military personnel, has been awarded by the Ukrainian Armed Forces for the fruitful cooperation and interaction in the defence of Ukraine's national interests.

In his address, the Chief of Defence extended this distinction to the entire Spanish Armed Forces, "this represents recognition of the military support provided by Spain to Ukraine in its struggle against the illegitimate and unjustified Russian aggression."

## THE FRIGATE 'ALMIRANTE JUAN DE BORBÓN' TOOK PART IN THE 'COLD RESPONSE 26' EXERCISE, IN THE NORTH OF NORWAY

This year, 'Cold Response' brought together 32,500 participants from 14 countries: Norway and Finland, the United States, the United Kingdom, Germany, The Netherlands, France, Italy, Canada, Spain, Turkey, Sweden, Denmark and Belgium. Involving forces from allied countries helps to strengthen interoperability between allied forces and NATO's deterrence capability in the High North.

Frigate Almirante Juan de Borbón reached the northernmost position ever recorded by this Spanish Navy vessel.

## UAMAM-UCRANIA



### UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES PERSONNEL HAVE RECEIVED TRAINING IN RONDA

Spanish Legion has hosted around seventy Ukrainian Armed Forces personnel at Montejaque Barracks, in Ronda, where they have received training in the Military Decision-Making Process (MDMP) and in Military Operations in Urban Terrain (MOUT) during the first quarter of 2026.

This has been the first time these training activities have been conducted at this location, as they were previously held in Almería.

As part of one of the key missions to protect vessels under the United Nations World Food Programme, the crew of the frigate Canarias paid a visit to the merchant vessel Ocean Benefit.

Both ships met in the port of Mombasa and took the opportunity to conduct a visit and explore aspects such as the measures taken to prevent incidents of piracy.

### OPV FUROR JOINED EUOMARFOR NAVAL TASK GROUP ALONGSIDE THE FRENCH SHIP COMMANDANT BOUAN

The integration of the OPV Furor into this naval group reinforces the multinational nature of the European deployment in the Gulf of Guinea. They demonstrated the ability of European navies to operate jointly in complex maritime environments.

These exercises contribute to improve operational coordination, mutual understanding of procedures and the effectiveness of future combined actions in the field of maritime security.
