SPAIN PARTICIPATED IN THE CONFERENCE ON CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF PARTIES TO THE CONFLICT

The Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons (CCW) was held in Geneva, analysing compliance with the protocols and the training and assistance activities carried out over the past year.

In the case of Spain, the Verification Unit (UVE) of the Defence Staff reported on various training and assistance activities carried out during the year 2024 in the Republics of Moldova, Poland, Switzerland and Germany.



THE JOINT CYBERSPACE COMMAND PARTICIPATED IN THE CYBERCO

This meeting, held in Budapest, brings together the European Union Cyber Commanders and is the main meeting point for cyber defence at the strategic level.

Such meetings and summits are of great relevance to the Joint Cyberspace Command because, on the one hand, the sharing of capabilities enables the definition of future goals and, on the other, they create opportunities for cooperation that otherwise would be very difficult to achieve.

NATO'S ENHANCED SURVEILLANCE ACTIVITIES, NEPTUNE STRIKE 24-2, WHICH WAS CONDUCTED IN MULTIPLE JOINT OPERATIONAL AREAS ACROSS EUROPE, CONCLUDED

The NEPTUNE STRIKE 24-2 operational activity concluded after several days of joint training, covering multiple joint operational areas across the Alliance's European territory.

The aim of this exercise was to increase the integration of naval forces from several countries to ensure the readiness and effectiveness of joint operations and thereby strengthen deterrence and defence strategies against evolving security challenges.

In the case of the Multinational Battle Group Slovakia (MN BG SVK), CERTEX 24-I was aimed to certify that this force is ready to conduct defensive operations within its area of responsibility.
