



Brigadier General Miguel Ángel Sáez Nievas

Born in 1971 in Barcelona, he joined the Spanish Air Force Academy in 1989 and was promoted to first lieutenant in 1994.

Regarding his operational assignments, he has been posted to Fighter Wings 12, 15 and 46 in different periods, logging more than 3.000 flying hours. He has also served in different staff positions, the most relevant being the Air Combat Command, the Cabinet of the Air Chief and the Air Operations Section of the Ops Division in the Air Force Headquarters. He commanded the Armament Section of the Air Force Logistics Command in Madrid.

Between 2022 and 2024, he was commander of the 12 Fighter Wing in Torrejon Air Base.

He took part in operations in the Balkans and commanded the Orion Detachment (EU ATALANTA Operation) in Djibouti in 2019. He served also as JFAC Coordinator both in the Spanish JFAC and in the French JFAC for its assignment to NATO Response Force 2014.
